Eligibility and Art Specifications

- Local area artists may submit 3 bird themed original works of art. The hanging committee will hang as many works as possible to fit existing display space. Four Springs holds the right to refuse art work not deemed appropriate.
- All work must relate to the theme of the show. Please label your work with your name, the title of the piece, the medium used, the price, and current contact information including your phone and e-mail address.
- 2-D work must be sturdily framed, including a hanging wire on the back.
- 3-D work must include any special installation instructions. Outside installation of sculptures will be installed by the artist with the direction of Lisa McDavid of Four Springs. Call to make arrangements.
- All artwork will be hand delivered during the above drop off date. If alternative arrangements are necessary please call Melanie.
- Bring a current resume or Art Bio to be placed in the Artist show book at Four Springs House. You may also want to bring a supply of business cards or other small marketing materials for the entry table.
- We do not carry insurance on artwork; we will do our best to care for your work and return it to you.

Sales

Art labels will be made and placed next to each piece. Please price your work to include sales tax. For work sold, Four Springs will hold cash or checks in the artist's name. Work will be sold off the wall at time of purchase. Participating artists agree to donate 10% of the sales price to Four Springs Preserve on art sold - these donated fees will be paid by the artist upon collection of the artwork sales money. The artist is responsible for payment of state sales tax on all sales.
